29th ANNUAL PEDIGREE® STAGE STOP SLED DOG RACE STARTS IN JACKSON.

The ceremonial start of the 29th annual Pedigree Stage Stop Sled Dog Race kicked off this Friday in downtown Jackson, Wyoming. The "Stage Stop" race is the premier event of sled dog sports and draws top competitors from across North America and Europe.

Stage One commences Saturday January 27th at 9:00 a.m. at the Black Rocks trailhead of the Bridger Teton National Forest near Moran Junction in Jackson Hole Wyoming. The Pedigree Stage Stop Race consists of seven individual stages. The race travels through seven mountain ranges of western Wyoming and Idaho on National Forest lands trails. Teams cover 30 to 35 miles per day on out-and-back courses.

The daily race schedule is as follows:

- * January 28 Stage Two Lander, Wyoming
- * January 29 Stage Three Pinedale, Wyoming
- * January 30 Stage Four Big Piney / Marbleton, Wyoming
- * January 31 Stage Five Kemmerer, Wyoming
- * February 1 Travel Day
- * February 2 Stage Six Alpine, Wyoming
- * February 3 Stage Seven & Final Banquet Driggs, Idaho
